Pacific Grove Shredding Day - On Saturday May 10, a cooperative community service project between the Pacific Grove Rotary Club and the Pacific Grove High School Interact Club was conducted from 9 am to 1pm. The purpose was to afford all residents an opportunity to dispose of confidential documents by shredding via a commercial licensed company. Four Interact representatives (Nicole Hage, Carol Nader, Kimberly Huynh and Sebastian Thal (an international exchange student from Germany) greeted each car, removed the document boxes, offered donuts and solicited donations. Janine Olin the Interact staff person from PGHS was present the entire time as well. The Rotary Club was represented by Jim Quinn (organizer), David Laws, Nate Steen (Interact liaison) and several others.

Shredding was done by the Same Day Shred (SDS) who brought a truck and secure containers and brought all 250 boxes to their facility to be shredded that same day. CC Salmina (SDS owner) generously offered his services without charge as a gift to PG residents. A total of 65+ individuals were relieved of their excess documents during the day and they generously donated over \$1,000 which will be used for local community projects and charities.

This was a win for the residents, for the Interact Club and for Rotary. A big thank you to all who participated and donated.

PACIFIC GROVE CONCOURS AUTO RALLY

The twentieth annual Pacific Grove Concoours Auto Rally, which has raised over \$190,000 for youth programs on the Monterey Peninsula, will be held on Friday, August 15, 2014. The event takes place on Friday of the Concoours d'Elegance weekend at Pebble Beach and the Rolex Monterey Motorsports Reunion at Laguna Seca.

The non-profit organization, Pacific Grove Youth Action was started in 1993 by then Mayor Jeanne Byrne, to support the Pacific Grove Youth Center. The Rally fundraiser was started in 1995. Through its twenty year history, rally beneficiaries have included the Pacific Grove Youth Center, the DARE programs for Pacific Grove and Carmel, Pacific Grove High School driver training scholarships and other youth programs. The Rotary Club of Pacific Grove joined Pacific Grove Youth Action seven years ago as a 50% partner for the rally organization. The Rotary Club of Pacific Grove provides volunteers and board member support.

The Pacific Grove Concoours Auto Rally is geared for people who own and drive their own classic and vintage cars. The rally draws over 200 participants and 8,000 spectators line the rally route. **Please join us in celebrating Fiat as the featured marquee in this year's event.**

The Pacific Grove Concoours Auto Rally will begin with a line-up on Lighthouse Avenue in Pacific Grove at 1:00 pm. The Rally Drive will start at 6:00 pm. Vintage and classic vehicles will follow a scenic route along the magnificent Pacific Grove shoreline through Pebble Beach; up Carmel's Ocean Avenue to Highway 1; returning to Pacific Grove for a 7:00 pm award BBQ dinner at historic Chautauqua Hall.

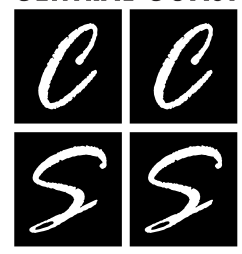
