PACIFIC GROVE CONCOURS AUTO RALLY

Pacific Grove Rotary and Pacific Grove Youth Action, Inc. (PGYA) put on the Pacific Grove Concours Auto Rally as a fund raiser for the Pacific Grove Youth Center and other PG and Carmel youth programs. The Auto Rally was started in 1995 by PGYA and was joined by PG Rotary. The event has donated over \$250,000 to assist the youth of Pacific Grove and Carmel by sponsoring after school tutoring and programs at the PG Youth Center, PG High School Driver's Training Scholarships, Carmel Mayor's Youth Fund and PG and Carmel DARE programs.

The Concours Auto Rally is held on the Friday afternoon and evening of the Concours weekend. This year's event will be on August 15, 2014 starting at 1pm with a lineup of vintage and sports cars on Lighthouse Ave.; at 6pm a drive around the Coast, through Pebble Beach and up Ocean Ave in Carmel; ending with a BBQ in PG.

The event draws 230 Rally cars and over 8,000 spectators along the route and back into PG.

Pacific Grove Rotarian Jeanne Byrne has agreed to continue as Chairman of the Event, a position she has held since its inception. Preliminary meetings are currently in progress.

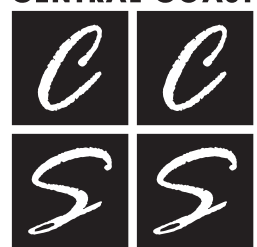
