



Dear Auto Rally Participant,

We are pleased that you are joining us for the 26th annual Rotary Club of Pacific Grove Auto Rally on Friday, August 14th. Your participation helps Rotary support important services, including the Teen Center, the Library children's section, and Pacific Grove Recreation Department.

To reach Weathertech Raceway Laguna Seca at 1021 Monterey Salinas Hwy, Salinas, take Highway 68 from Monterey or Salinas. Immediately after turning into the entrance you will find a 'Y' in the road. Take the right fork and drive up the hill. There may be a check at the guard shack, so please have your documents ready to confirm your participation in the rally. Shortly after that look for signs or volunteers directing you to where we are staging the cars. The registration table will be open from 12:00 to 1:00.

Monterey County Board of Supervisors approved an ordinance on July 28 allowing for fines for those disregarding the prevailing state face covering health order for all areas in unincorporated Monterey County. As Laguna Seca falls within that jurisdiction, Raceway officials have asked that everybody remain in their cars so we meet the requirement of social distancing. For the health of your passengers, fellow drivers, and pocket book, wear your mask. If you need to use the restroom.

At the registration table you will be given a map of the route, written directions, and a car number. Place the car number in the lower right-hand corner of your windshield so that CHP officers directing drivers back out on to Highway 68 will know that you are a member of the rally group.

Our Cruze will start at 1:00. To ensure safety on this busy road, CHP officers will determine how many drivers are released onto the highway at one time. Participants are expected to obey driving laws and all the rules of the road without exception. Be aware that the initial stretch of the drive is through a busy agricultural area. Look out for slow, heavily-laden vehicles and take care to share the road with cyclists. The drive is about 80 miles and will take 2 hours or so, longer if you wish to stop anywhere along the route to enjoy the beauty of our area. There are no services until you reach Carmel Valley Village.

The Cruze ends when you reach Highway 1. From here, you have several options. You can continue to Pacific Grove for a nice dinner in one of our outdoor restaurants or visit other beautiful areas on the Monterey Peninsula.
